

### **Campbellsport High School Students and Parents:**

The Middle School and both Elementary Schools are doing eLearning virtually until returning for instruction on Monday November 9th. The reason for that change was simply because we had ‘run out’ of teaching staff even covering classes internally. The High School staff has now reached that same issue with several new quarantines or positive test results. It is with that info and data posted by the County today of the continued rise in the Campbellsport School District community of positive cases; that **the High School will be moving to complete eLearning until November 9th** as of tomorrow Wednesday October 28. Throughout the District there are now twenty (20) staff members out due to contact with a positive case, testing positive themselves or other medical related leaves. Mr. O’Connor will be sending out an email to provide further details for the High School.

### **Tech Centers Opening:**

Chromebook distribution has happened for Grades 3 on up for all students needing a device at home during this time. If you cannot connect to the internet, the District will have two Tech Centers open for your students to use so they may access the internet. One is located at Eden Elementary in the Music Room (enter at the Gym entrance) and the other in the MS-HS Cafeteria (located off of Hwy. V - enter Door L). Both locations will be open from 12 noon until 7pm Monday thru Friday. Seating is limited to maintain social distancing and masks are required. These will be supervised by District staff and parents may accompany their students as needed. Please check to see if there is space available before you leave your student and pick them up promptly.

This ‘period of eLearning’ will hopefully allow most staff to return to a workable status. Again, we will be returning to the models used by each building earlier on November 9th. The staff would love to continue to teach traditionally but the numbers make it difficult at this time. Be safe and healthy.
