## Health & Wellness Policy For In-Person Instruction

Please read these important messages as your child transitions back into in-person learning.

\*\*Students who refuse to wear a mask will receive disciplinary actions which may include student being sent home for the day and possible automatic transfer to Remote-In Learning Platform.

1. Parents/Guardians will be required to sign/submit a Health and Wellness Certification Form daily to monitor their child(ren) before sending them to school.
2. Students with a temperature of 100.4 (or greater than) will be sent to Health Office for additional screening.
3. Parents/Guardians and staff member must notify school office anytime someone tests positive for COVID. This will also include close contacts within the household. School personnel will ask specific questions about a child's absence.
4. Students or staff awaiting COVID testing results, regardless of the circumstance, may not attend any in-person learning
5. A student who presents with symptoms of illness during school hours will be immediately sent to the Health Office for screening and separated if symptoms warrant possible COVID. Parents/Guardians are required to have their symptomatic child(ren) picked up immediately. Symptomatic children should be taken to their primary care physician for further medical evaluation.
6. Students and/or staff sent home with suspected COVID symptoms may not return to school unless one of the following occurs:
  - Student and/or staff remain home for at least 10 days from when symptoms first appeared, AND they are fever free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications, AND they have improvement of symptoms
  - OR
  - Students and/or staff receive **negative result from an RT-PCR molecular test**
  - Students and/or staff an alternative diagnosis was determined by your health care provider

7. Siblings, even those who present no symptoms, of a student who present COVID symptoms must also be sent home. They may return to school when one of the following has occurred:
  - Negative RT-PCR COVID test** of student sent home with symptoms
  - OR student sent home with symptoms is diagnosed with alternative diagnosis
  - OR at least 14 days have passed
8. Children of symptomatic parents/guardians or other household contacts should remain at home for 14 days, unless household contact has negative COVID test and/or alternative diagnosis
9. The health office will report any COVID diagnoses to the McHenry County Department of Public Health.
10. Students who cannot attend in-person instruction for extended periods of time due to illness or quarantine will receive accommodations to continue to attend school using an electronic platform. This will be arranged on a case by case basis.
