Dear Parents/Guardians of current Senior Students:

Immunizations are an important part of protecting your child's, your family's, and your community's health.

Emmons County Public Health understands that it can be difficult to find time to get your children vaccinated and would like to help by providing these immunizations at convenient times and locations.

ECPH nurses will be coming to Linton Public School on Thursday, March 30th from 1-3pm to offer immunizations to any 6th to 12th graders that are due.

As a current Senior, your child is highly recommended but not required to have the following immunizations before the start of their freshman college year:

- Diphtheria, Pertussis, and Tetanus (DTaP)
- Hepatitis A
- Human Papillomavirus HPV-9
- Polio (IPV)
- Meningococcal Meningitis (MCV4)
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis (Tdap)
- Hepatitis B
- Haemophilus influenza type b (Hib)
- O Pneumococcal Pneumonia (PCV 13)
- O Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR)
- Meningococcal B (Men B) 2 doses
- O Varicella (chickenpox)

If your child has already received these immunizations, please just disregard this letter. An immunization administration form is posted on the school website if you would like your child to receive this vaccination today, just fill out the front page.

Emmons County Public Health is in network with Sanford Health, BCBS, Medicaid or if you have no insurance at all. Parents do not need to be present for these immunizations but are always welcome!
