Parents and Guardians,

The Milbank School District's application for free school breakfast and lunch has been approved by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA). The school district will provide free breakfast and lunch for all students enrolled in the Milbank Schools and St. Lawrence. If your student wishes to purchase extra milk it will be charged to their lunch account. Cash must be paid at time of purchase for extra entrée's and other ala carte items.

This program will run from November 2, 2020 through June 30, 2021. The school encourages families to please pay off negative lunch accounts before the end of the school year. The regular cost of meals will begin again with the start of the 2021-22 school year.

Distance and remote learners may sign up to receive meals. We ask parents to please contact Food Service Director, Deb Underwood at 605-432-5579 extension 1360 each Friday by 2:30 PM for the following week. Meals-to-go are to be picked up at the high school's southeast entrance door number 3 from 10:30 AM to 11:00 AM on Mondays and Wednesdays to avoid the times when the students at school are being served. Multiple meals will be served at each pickup. Each participant will receive 2 breakfast and lunch meals on Mondays and 3 breakfast and lunch meals on Wednesdays. Three days of meals will be offered on Monday, November 23, 2020 with no service on November 25th.

Meals can only be picked up by a student or that child's parent or guardian, you cannot pick up meals for people who are not in your family. Students who are attending school in-person will go through the line just like they normally would for the meals.
