Remote Learning Plan-12:20 Dismissal Time: SHORT TERM

Priorities:

- Utilize a remote option as close to the current student learning model as possible.
- Provide students and teachers with structures that allow learning to continue even when remote.

Guidelines:

The same daily/weekly schedule will continue to be used.

- Meet in synchronous classes at a minimum of two times per week (following A/B and period schedules), barring teacher illness
 - All meetings will be scheduled via Google Meets or Google Hangouts.
 - Notice to students of meetings must be given at least 24 hours in advance.
 - Some courses may choose to meet more than twice, but should still follow the course schedule.
 - Class meetings may be as long as 50 minutes (regular class period), but that is not required.
 - Study Hall classes will not meet synchronously, but students are encouraged to reach out for help if needed.
- All teachers will utilize Google Classroom to assign work and post class materials.
 - All class assignments will be posted prior to 3:00 pm each school day.
 - All work will be due in the same manner as while in school.
- Students will utilize Google Classroom or other programs to turn in assignments. Other programs or platforms include but are not limited to Khan Academy, Quizlet, DeltaMath, WebAssign, or Big Ideas Math. (Note: the assignments will be posted on Google Classroom, but how they are turned in can vary.)
- Teachers will be available for student questions from 2:00-3:00 Monday through Friday, barring teacher illness.
- Tests may be given at the discretion of the classroom teacher.
- Major internet problems should be discussed with an administrator--if a student does not have access to the internet or technology, he or she needs to reach out for help.
- Students can request to set up a Google Meets with a teacher(s) for additional help.
