Due to the percentage of Little River Jr./Sr. High students and four staff members being quarantined, along with three positive COVID-19 tests, all 7th-12th grade students will continue remote learning for next week, November 2nd through November 6th. If you receive no further notifications, plan on returning in person on Monday, November 9th. **ALL** 7th-12th grade students will be expected to log on at their regular scheduled class time and to expect a Zoom Meeting invite from their teachers. Pre-K-6th grade students will continue to go in person as normal.

Transportation for Pre-K through 6th grade will run as usual. Please be aware that pick up/drop off times may vary slightly. If your child(ren) will not be attending school, please notify your bus driver AND Windom Elementary School.

A reminder that remote learning students can pick up free meals during this week and we encourage you to take advantage of this service. Any remote learning student's parents will need to contact their school of choice by 9:00 a.m. if you would like to receive the free meals, (a lunch and a breakfast for the next day). These meals will be provided for the family group and parents or students will be responsible for picking up the meals at the school of their choice between 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Any 7th through 12th grade student will have the opportunity to pick up any school supplies, (laptop, textbooks, etc.), during the regular school day, if needed. Please check in at the office prior to picking up your items.

Jr. High boys and girls basketball practice will begin Monday, November 2nd, at 3:45 p.m. and will end at 5:30 p.m. High School football will continue practice as normal. There will be no after practice route for the week of November 2nd through November 9th.

A reminder that if you have been identified as a close contact and contacted by the Health Department or the school, you cannot attend any school activities until you are released. Thank you for your cooperation to help assure students can continue to come to school.
