Dear Students, Parents and Guardians,

The new 2-week daily rate of new cases of COVID-19 per 100,000 people has been released. Lebanon's rate has dropped for the second reporting period in a row. For the 2-week period ending October 24, Lebanon had 4 new cases for a rate of 4 cases/100,000 people. The data is updated every Thursday by 5:00 p.m., <https://data.ct.gov/stories/s/COVID-19-data/wa3g-tfvc/>. The State data website also includes updates on COVID-19 cases in schools. When you view the data you will see that across the state there have been very few cases of COVID-19 in schools.

Lebanon is one of the few towns with dropping numbers in our area of Connecticut. Overall, CT numbers are increasing. A gentle reminder that if cases do occur in our schools or there is a sudden spike in COVID-19 cases in Lebanon, we may have to make a quick change to Hybrid or Distance Learning. Students, remember to bring you devices and chargers home with you on a daily basis.
