Dear Geneva Teachers and Staff,

The Geneva Area City School District wishes to inform you that the Local Health Department is investigating a case of COVID-19 at Geneva High School.

During the time that the cases were potentially infectious, the students were in school with their last day on Friday, October 23rd from 7:15 am - 2:30 pm, the cases reported to have visited only Geneva High School in Geneva, Ohio. The students, a 10th grade student and an 11th grade student, received positive tests result on or around Friday, October 30, 2020. One of the students, the 11th grade student, attended a practice / after school activity on Sat., October 24th.

COVID-19 is a contagious respiratory disease that is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person from people who are in close contact. Generally, close contact is defined as being within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more. Symptoms of COVID-19 typically appear 2-14 days after exposure and may include fever/chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficult breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.
