## Granby Summer Enrichment

## Week 1 (July 10th-July 14th)

Drawing and Painting: Students will explore a variety of drawing, painting, and printmaking materials during this one week summer enrichment program. We will draw from our imaginations as well as from real life objects and people. We will take our art outside and draw nature and landscapes. Students will explore both watercolor and tempera paint materials to bring their art to life. Students will build their own sketchbook, which they will use to draw what they see around them. Students will turn their drawings into prints when we learn about and practice our printmaking skills. We will study a variety of artists from history to present day. Students will leave this program with a lot of new knowledge about drawing and painting and many completed paintings and drawings.

Students will study fiber art techniques including weaving, stitchery, and fabric art. They will also explore a variety of sculpture materials including paper, clay, and found materials. We will go outside and build sculptures out of natural materials. We will study a variety of artists from history to present day. Students will leave this program with a lot of new knowledge about sculpture and fiber arts and many completed sculptures and fiber artworks.

This will be a fun, hands-on, engineering experience for all!
