Counselor's Corner

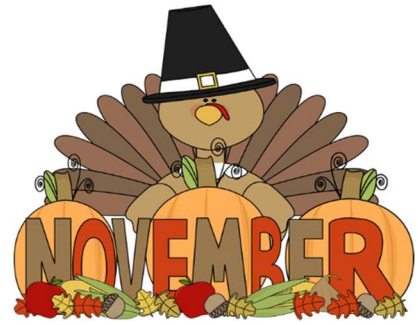
Dear Parents,
