3. Complete the application and return it to us at MCFS.

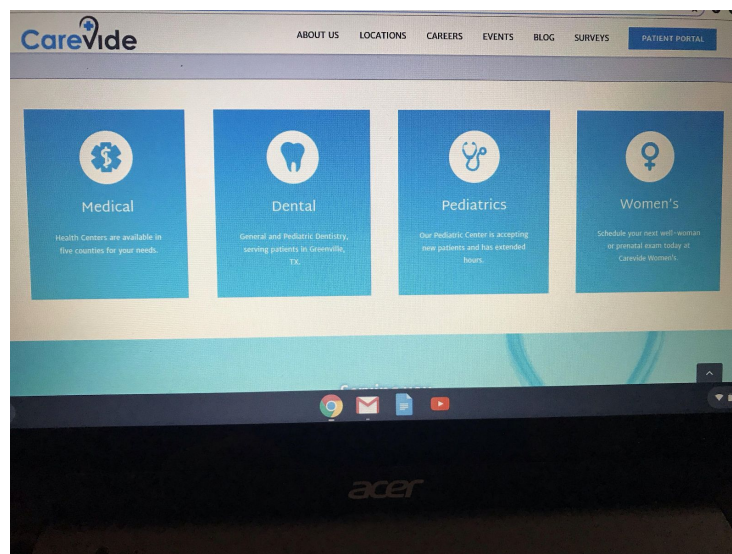
