Choose one of the following options to satisfy the edTPA requirement:

- Submit an official edTPA score taken for licensure in another state
 - o Complete form 80-01A Out-of-State Applicant Verification of edTPA
- While serving on an educator license with stipulations endorsed as a provisional educator, complete the edTPA while employed as a teacher in an Illinois school district
- Enroll in the student teaching portion of a state-approved educator preparation program offered by an Illinois institution of higher education and complete the edTPA
- Provide evidence of having at least **one** year of full-time teaching experience and achieving a "proficient" or higher rating, or the equivalent, on your most recent performance evaluation.
 - o Complete form 80-01 Out-of-State Applicant Request to Waive edTPA
 - Provide an official letter from the school district(s) verifying years of full-time teaching experience
 - If experience was accumulated at more than one district, each district should send a letter. The combined experience must total 1 full year, or 2 semesters, of full-time teaching.
- Provide evidence of completing a comparable Teacher Performance Assessment.
 - o Have your College/University complete form <u>80-02</u>: <u>State-Approved Program and Completion of Standards Verification</u>
- → All educators who have completed student teaching prior to August 31, 2015 are eligible to complete either the Assessment of Professional Teaching (APT 188) or the edTPA:
 - APT(188) no longer available as of 10/12/2020
