

## Virtual Learning Application and Process

Dear Parents:

Virtual Learning for grades K-12 will be made available for those families who elect to have their child enrolled in the Chattahoochee County School District but require an alternative to traditional, in-person instruction. Families considering a virtual learning option should be aware that this option will require a commitment of at least one semester of enrollment. In addition, the parent will be required to demonstrate that their child will have access to working technology, reliable internet, and appropriate supervision to work independently. A limited number of devices may be available for checkout from Chattahoochee County Schools.

A parent must register their child for the Virtual Learning option no later than November 19, 2020. The application is available [HERE](#). Using this model, students will be assigned a user license from an instructional technology platform that corresponds to the student's grade level and personalized learning profile based from assessment data. By registering your child for the Virtual Learning option, you are agreeing to all the requirements of Virtual Learning:

1. The student has access to reliable Wi-Fi connection
2. The student will remain enrolled in Virtual Learning for at least one semester
3. The student will have adequate supervision to complete the requirements of Virtual Learning
4. The student will complete the assigned modules as expected
5. Grading will be based on the performance of the student as recorded by the technology platform.
6. Attendance requirements will be met by the student completion of all items assigned to include engagement, access, and communication with technology platform
