Minutes of the Board of Education Meeting March 9, 2020 Kilgore Elementary School

1. The regular Board of Education Meeting was called to order by President Adam Naslund at 6:37 p.m. Roll call – all members were present. Adam Lambert, Donna Blocker and 20 guests were in attendance. President Naslund verified the posting of the Open Meetings Act, the meeting time & place.
