March 10, 2014

1. The regular Board of Education Meeting was called to order by Vice-President Chris Galloway at 6:30 p.m. Roll call with five members were present and Mark is on his way. Chris verified the posting of the Open Meetings Act, the meeting time and place. Mark arrived at 6:45.
2. It was moved by Debbie Compton & seconded by Betty Williams to approve consent agenda items including the minutes of the February 10, 2013 meeting and the general fund claims in the amount of \$191,341.05. Roll call vote. Motion carried 5-0.

New Business:

1. It was moved by Betty Williams & seconded by Missy Rosfeld to approve the 2014/2015 School Calendar as presented. Roll call vote. Motion carried 5-0.

Superintendents Report:

Mr. Chessmore shared information about the Government Relations Information Teams Conference. The Superintendent Pay Transparency Act will become effective on July 1, 2014. The Attendance Laws will need to reviewed annually in policy. An update on LB682 - 160 school districts sent letters opposing this. Senator Davis feels he has enough votes to defeat this bill. LB145 & LB670, both bills to reduce the valuation of ag land died in committee on a 4-4 vote. LB725 to lower the Local Effort Rate to \$1.00 was placed on final reading. We will be working on our Safety/Emergency Plan at the Staff work day on March 28th. The elementary students raised \$206.19 for the Pennies for Patients Program. He also shares an expense comparison between last year & this year in the General Fund.

3. It was moved by Missy Rosfeld and seconded by Debbie Compton to enter into Executive Session for the Superintendent Evaluation at 7:00. Roll call vote. Motion carried 6-0.
4. It was moved by Debbie Compton and seconded by Adam Naslund to come out of Executive Session at 7:30 pm.
