



CPPS has determined a need for our schools to return to **Full Remote Learning effective Monday, November 9**. Parents/guardians may opt to have their students stay at home the remainder of this week (November 4-6) to work from home if they choose to do so.

We will continue to monitor county and city conditions with an anticipated return to our Hybrid Learning Model on Monday, November 30, 2020.

**Full Remote Learning Model.** Below is specific information:

- **Full Remote Learning Model:** CPPS will return to the Full Remote Learning Model 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. with LIVE instruction from 9:00-12:00 daily for all students. There will be required online and remote learning components from 12:30-3:00 daily as well.
- **Specific Program/Class/Grade Level Information:** Please watch for communications with specific information for your student from your school's teachers and administrators in the next couple of days. These communications will lay out the individual plan for your student.
- **Life Skills & Preschool:** As we did to begin the school year, CPPS will continue to serve students identified as the most vulnerable who cannot access learning from home.
- **Athletics/Activities:** All athletics and activities will return (or remain) virtual beginning November 9th as well. We will continue to evaluate the conditions for a return as these extracurricular activities are governed by an entirely different set of guidelines, yet cannot be done safely given the current conditions.
- **Grab n' Go Meal Delivery:** Meals will be available for pickup from 11:45-1:15 at Davis Elementary and CPHS. We will resume delivery to Homestead and Valle Lindo during the same times
