- ED 220 *Introduction to Educating Individuals with Diverse Abilities in K-12 Classrooms*
- ED 408 *Diagnosis & Assessment of Learners with Exceptional Needs in K-12 Classrooms*

-Students must receive a grade of C- or better in each class.

-Students must pass Content Test #155 to be entitled for the endorsement.

- Most practicing teachers will have completed ED 115 (or an articulated transfer class) in their undergraduate program. Therefore, they will only need to complete the remaining three courses for the Special Education Endorsement. Millikin’s Registrar’s Office determines course articulations.

-Price is \$1497 per 3cr. hr. course.

-Limited \$500-\$1000 scholarships are available.
