Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are currently going through some challenging times as the cases of COVID-19 are beginning to rise in Holt County. With that said, everyone in our building is continuing to work very hard at disinfecting the building and making sure our students are washing their hands and using sanitizer on a regular basis. In an effort to help deep clean and disinfect the building in preparation for the last part of 2nd quarter/1st Semester, **we are going to teach virtually on November 23rd and 24th (no students in our building for instruction)**. The teachers will be discussing this with your students as the time comes and information will be relayed home on how instruction will look on these 2 days.

Mound City R-2 will still provide lunch for these 2 days. Both meals will be provided on Monday, November 23rd. If you plan for your students to receive meals for these 2 days, please contact the school by November 20th at 816-273-7119 to let us know.

The intent of this decision is not to cause a hardship for anyone, but to help try to prevent more spread of sickness in our school community. We feel that letting you know a couple weeks in advance will give everyone ample time in planning for these 2 days. We are scheduled to have a JH Basketball game on November 23rd and a HS Basketball game on November 24th. These games will not be played on these dates, but will be rescheduled if possible.

I also want to take this time to let everyone know that there will be limitations on attendance for the upcoming Mound City Invitational Basketball Tournament. Due to concerns with having so many individuals from different communities at the same time, we are going to take precautions in order to provide a safe environment for everyone in attendance. Once final decisions have been made we will distribute the information to the community and each school in attendance.

This is a tough time of year as we all struggle to determine if we have common cold symptoms or if its COVID-19 symptoms. We encourage frequent hand washing and if your student is not feeling well, err on the side of caution and keep them home to help prevent the spread of sickness in our building.
