Request for Emergency Approval of Housing Aid Reimbursement

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to you today to notify you that Barrington Public Schools is requesting the Commissioner's Emergency approval of \$449,775 from the Rhode Island Department of Education's School Building Authority to address immediate health and safety concerns. Our request includes projects at the Barrington High School, Nayatt Elementary School, and Primrose Hill Elementary School that have immediate needs for the with the repair/replacement of rooftop heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) units, installation of a building management system, and improvements to our sidewalks that will allow us to be compliant with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990.

Replacement of rooftop HVAC units are extremely important to of our buildings that are currently unable to receive the proper heating, ventilation and air flow that were previously being provided and now have become more essential during the pandemic.

We are seeking an installation of a building management system at high school to help control and monitor our buildings HVAC system and to notify us whenever there is a malfunction or a condition of inoperability in our system.

Additionally, we are looking to make improvements to our sidewalks/walkday at Primrose Hill School. This improvement will improve the building egress and provide compliance with ADA regulations to safely allow safer dismissal from our school's grounds. We lastly would like to note that we are currently in process of formulating our Necessity of School Construction Stage II application. With the approval of this emergency request, our school department will be able to address the immediate concern and bridge our current gap from when our Memorandum of Agreement ended in December 2021 till when we are able to enter into a new Agreement. As time goes on, however, additional immediate projects may need to be completed in our schools during this gap and we plan to submit those projects in writing, in the future.


