My student may be sick, what do I do?

COVID-19 Symptoms

Contact your doctor if you have any of these symptoms:



Fever



Chills



Cough



Shortness of breath
or difficulty breathing



Fatigue



Muscle or
body aches



Headache



New loss of
taste or smell



Sore throat



Congestion or
runny nose



Nausea or
vomiting



Diarrhea

10 Day Quarantine

You must quarantine your student for 10 days and the student must be symptom free without the aid of medication for 24 hours before coming back on campus.

or

Doctors Note

You must get a doctor's note clearing your student and the student must be symptom free without the aid of medication for 24 hours before coming back on campus.

or

COVID-19 Test

You must get a negative COVID-19 test and have no fever or vomiting without the aid of medication before 24 hours before coming back on campus.

Can my sick student's sibling still attend school?

Yes, a sick student's sibling may still attend school if they do not exhibit any symptoms and the sick student or family member has not tested positive for COVID-19.

What do I do if I or someone in my home test positive for COVID-19?

Please notify the school and all members of the home must quarantine for 14 days and must be symptom free without the aid of medication for 24 hours before coming back on campus.

I know this creates a considerable inconvenience on your family, but we are required to follow these mandates by the Oregon Health Authority. These steps also ensure that we can maintain the least restrictive learning environment for all our students.
