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Northeastern Local Students & Parents,

We hope that everyone is staying safe and enjoying this summer-like weather in November! As the first quarter is ending and COVID numbers in our area are climbing, we wanted to take this opportunity to reinforce our COVID protocols and also provide clarity about our makeup work policy for students that are quarantined by the health department.

Our students and staff have done a tremendous job throughout the beginning of the school year following our protocols and allowing us to continue to have 5-day, face-to-face instruction. We will continue to sanitize our classrooms at an accelerated pace and try to do our part to make our schools as safe as possible. We would like to remind students to wear their masks over their mouth and nose at all times throughout the school day other than during lunch and during assigned mask break times. Our ability to do this, will only increase our chances of staying as safe as possible.

If your child would happen to test positive for COVID, they will be excused from school and given their appropriate time to recover. We will follow all guidance provided to us by our local health department as far as when students should return to school. Once your child starts to feel better, we expect them to complete their assigned work.

If your child is being tested for COVID, they will be excused from school while they await results. If your child receives a negative result, we need to get documentation from their health care provider that releases them to return to school with exact dates. If your child is not experiencing any symptoms during this time, we expect them to complete their assigned work.

If your child would happen to get quarantined due to exposure to a person that has been identified to have COVID, they will also be excused from school during this time. However, these students will be expected to keep up with their classroom work. Middle School and High School teachers will be placing assignments on Google Classroom for them to complete once they begin to feel better or are being quarantined due to exposure. Tinora Elementary students should pick up assignment packets and Chromebooks from TES. While some elementary assignments may be in Google Classroom, other assignments will be given in the packet that is picked up. We encourage our students to keep up with their assignments when possible so that they do not fall behind and are overwhelmed with makeup work. We also encourage students and parents to communicate with teachers via email with any questions or concerns that they may have. It is our expectation that students would complete all work by the time they return to school from being quarantined.

If students would need anything from school, please contact your child's school office and we will make arrangements to get them any school books that they may need. We will work to be as flexible as possible.
