As we prepare to tip off the 2020-2021 Outlaw and Lady Outlaw basketball seasons, the following procedures and protocols set forth by the Arkansas Department of Health and the Arkansas Activities Association will be followed by the Dierks School District in order for our student activities to proceed this school year. We understand the current circumstances are less than ideal but greatly appreciate your efforts to comply with the following guidelines below for these activities to continue.

- The 6 foot social distancing and face masks requirement for everyone over the age of 10, in accordance with the Arkansas Department of Health guidelines, must be worn by all in attendance in all areas of J&L Johnson Gymnasium.
- The admission gate will open thirty (30) minutes before the first game.
- Arkansas Activities Association (AAA) and local passes will be accepted unless the gymnasium capacity has been reached.
- Ticket allotments were determined by allowing each player four (4) tickets each to be presented at the admission gate with \$5 per ticket. Having the correct change will not only reduce the amount of time standing in line, it will provide a safer environment for those working in the admission gate by reducing money exchanged. A minimal number of general admission tickets will be determined nightly on the number of games, combination of teams playing, and number of tickets not utilized by the opposing team.
- Ticket allotments will also be provided to the players' parents of the opponent.
- Bleacher seating will be available on every other row at six (6) foot increments, with the only allowable exception being for families to sit together.
- The concession stands will be open but will be limited on the number of items to sale to comply with current guidelines.
- Children must remain with a parent, guardian, or supervising adult at all times.
- No gatherings will be allowed before, during, or at the completion of the games.
- Efforts are being made to provide a livestream option for Outlaw fans who are unable to attend.
- Although not a requirement, the Arkansas Activities Association recommends vacating the gym once your child's game is over to allow others to show their support as well.
