The Theresa Utterback Family Scholarship- Application

This award, established in 2013 by the children of Theresa B. Utterback (1920-1992), is intended to provide a financial award to a deserving Alliance High School senior who demonstrates a clear financial need to assist them with higher education plans. Theresa Utterback successfully raised seven children, all graduates of AHS. She did this as a single parent for most of her adult life. Although Mrs. Utterback was not a high school graduate, her belief in her children was based on the principles of hard work, perseverance and no excuses. Thus preference for this award will be given to a lower income single parent recipient from a similar background. However, an applicant from a lower income two parent family with demonstrable need will be given full consideration and should apply. The assistance is for higher education costs that are clearly not covered by other scholarships, awards, assistance, work study, and support from family, relatives, and friends. The fundamental principle is to help people help themselves- they earn it. The award is for \$4,000 which will be made in three installments:

\$1,000 at the senior award ceremony subject to enrollment verification to higher ed.
\$1,000 after the recipient has successfully completed their first academic year of higher education and submits verification of sophomore year enrollment.
\$2,000 after the recipient has successfully completed their second academic year of higher education and submits verification of junior year enrollment.

Grade point average from high school must be at least a 2.5 GPA Attach a copy
of your official transcript.
The applicant's family annual income should be no more than \$70,000.00.
Preference will be given to single parent households with lower income. However, an applicant from a two parent family with demonstrable need will be given full consideration.
Attach a copy of your FASFA (Student Aid Report) the applicant and parents completed must be also be submitted with the application.
Proof of enrollment must also be provided with written documentation from the registrar's office of the college before the actual monetary award is granted.
Attach a copy of your transcript.
