Can you believe it! A full nine weeks has come and gone. We would like to thank you for trusting Scott Elementary School with your child(ren)'s education for the first nine weeks. As we enter a new nine weeks, many of you are transitioning from a virtual learning modality to face-to-face (F2F) instruction. Because of this transition, changes will be made to classroom homerooms and assigned seating. You will not see schedule adjustments in Infinite Campus until after report cards are sent home on Friday, November 13, 2020. Thank you for your patience and continued flexibility as we make this transition in the coming weeks. Our goal is to make sure all staff and students are safe and prepared for dynamic learning.

All students participated in the Early Release day on 11.06.2020. For students who are enrolled in F2F instruction, you are expected to report to school on Monday, November 9, 2020 by 8:00 a.m. Students who are continuing in virtual learning will join your virtual teacher's classroom on **Wednesday, November 11, 2020**. *However, SES Virtual Learners can opt to stay active on Monday and Tuesday, by working on assignments in EXACT Path, Lexia, Dreambox, Study Island, and MyOn/Accelerated Reader each day.*

All returning virtual learners must bring TCity's Chromebooks and report to the Media and Technology Specialists in the SES Library upon return to F2F instruction. All returning students are required to be in dress code, wear a face mask or goiter, and adhere to CDC guidelines.

Please make sure your child knows how s/he is going home. You must apply for bus transportation (<https://www.tcitys.org/page/transportation>) and wear a face mask to ride the bus.
