

FAN BUS POLICY

Pick up points and delivery – Campbellsburg, West Washington, Livonia, Hardinsburg and Fredericksburg.

RULES:

1. Only West Washington Students grades 7-12 are eligible to ride the fan bus.
2. Students are to exit the front doors of the bus only.
3. Students are not to leave the gym until the game is completed.
4. Students are not to board the bus until the bus driver is present.
5. Students are to behave themselves at pick-up points.
6. All school rules are in effect.

TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS
FOR
FIELD TRIPS AND ATHLETIC EVENTS

1. All field trips are to be approved by the principal and then by the Board of School Trustees. All requests for such trips must include:
 - A. Number of students going
 - B. Male and female sponsors if both boys and girls are going overnight.
 - C. Date and time leaving and arriving back at West Washington
 - D. Destination and reason for trip
 - E. Method of transportation – must comply with all standards governing public transportation of the State of Indiana and the Federal Government and be furnished by a proven reliable firm.
 - F. Cost to student and amount paid by the sponsoring group.
 2. School buses will be used to transport students on field trips or athletic events. Any exception must be approved by the Superintendent.

BEREAVEMENT DAYS: In case of death in the immediate family, absence without loss of pay shall be granted for a period of not more than five (5) days. These days shall not exceed seven (7) calendar days beyond the date of death. Immediate family shall be interpreted as father, mother, sister, brother, spouse, child, mother-in-law, father-in-law, grandchild, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, step-father, step-mother, or any other relative living at the time of death as a member of the household of the teacher.

I.

Two (2) day's absence with pay shall be granted for the death of a grandparent or grandparent-in-law and brother/sister in-law.

J.

One (1) day's absence with pay shall be granted for the death of an uncle, aunt, first cousin, niece, nephew, not living in the household of the teacher. If the distance is such as to require an extra day for travel, this could be taken from sick leave if desired.
