QUALIFICATIONS FOR SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER

C. Qualifications (last revised Oct. 21, 1991)

Eligibility requirements for members of the Board of School Trustees are as follows:

- 1. Must be a registered voter in the State of Indiana
- 2. Must be a minimum of twenty-one years of age
- 3. Must be a resident in the State of Indiana for two (2) years or more, a resident of the West Washington School District for one (1) or more years, and a resident in the area for which they are running or are to be appointed.
- 4. Cannot hold another "lucrative office." A "lucrative office" is a position which involves the exercise of the sovereign powers of the State of Indiana and an office to which compensation, of any kind, whether salary or per diem is attached. Article 2, Section 9, of the Constitution of the State of Indiana. Also, in the Indiana Election Code 3-8-1-3.
- 5. Cannot be an employee with the West Washington School Corporation, the Lost River Career Center or the South Central Area Special Education Cooperative.
