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MAP Assessments assess student knowledge. As students do well on a test, the next test becomes more difficult. They use it three times each year. A MAP Progress Report is sent home to parents each time after each Map Assessment. Another instrument used is Classworks. It is an instructional tool geared toward helping each student reach academic success. It is online so it can be used at school and at home. It creates individualized learning paths.

Jeff Morton thanked Miss Hamm for the meal. He congratulated the high schools on the SAT scores. Bryan County High School's 100 point gain is amazing. Teachers all the way down should be proud. He stated that last night Dr. Brooksher, Mrs. Herndon, Mr. Barnes, and he went to Jesup for a meeting to talk about the constitutional amendment. If you read the amendment it is very innocent. It says "Shall the constitution be amended to allow state or local approval of public charter schools to form upon the request of local communities?' That sounds great but right now the local communities can go to the local school boards to get charter schools, so the only change in there is that it would allow the state to form charter schools without the approval of the local system. The scary part about it is the people that are pushing this -91% of the money they have raised has come from out-of-state. It's not like a grass roots. This is something that is being pushed by management companies – follow the money and you will know what is happening. Encourage everyone to look into this amendment. It is the first amendment and don't be fooled by the language. All the professional organizations of teachers across the board are opposed to this. It is scary because the way it is written, it sounds like a great idea but really what it is doing is under minding. We know all the money that is taken out of our school system through austerity cuts. If they start forming these charter schools at the state level, that is going to be more money taken out of our schools.

Dr. Brooksher stated he wanted to reinforce that they did attend an information session. He stated we will provide as much education as we can. He is working on a plan.

Eddie Warren stated everyone has to talk about it. We need to let everyone know what it means. He thanked Miss Hamm for the great food. He thanked Tiffany Hursey for the presentation. He congratulated the grant winners. He congratulated the high schools and the principals for the SAT scores. He thanked the board for all the work they have put in. Looking through the minutes, we had five meetings in a short period of time. The board has done a lot of work Board Minutes Page 7 September 27, 2012

recently. Also looking at SPLOST and the dollars collected – if we continue at the pace we should end up with almost \$1.4 million more than projected. That is about a 5.9% increase. When you look at 2009, we were behind every month. We have really made up that ground. That is looking good. We may be able to put in the soccer fields. He asked the board members if they receive the <u>American School</u> magazine. He stated there is an article in it titled "How Schools Should Build". It has some very helpful information in it.

The Bryan County Board of Education met on Thursday, December 20, 2012, at 6:30 p.m., at Richmond Hill High School, for its monthly meeting.
