CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

POLICY #330

The Board of Education has a responsibility for maintaining a minimum program of instruction guaranteed by the state statutes and for initiating improvements beyond that minimum. The District's curriculum and instructional programs shall be planned in line with the academic standards adopted by the Board.

Professional staff, under the direction and supervision of the Superintendent, shall be delegated the responsibility for proposing and developing curriculum changes and additions. Communication and coordination among grade level and subject area teachers should be emphasized on a K-12 basis whenever curriculum is developed.

All subject area offerings and any additions to the curriculum shall be reviewed and adopted by the Board before they are initiated. Suggested deletions for the existing program of instruction shall be reviewed and approved by the Board before being dropped.
