

Instructional objectives and learning outcomes shall be prepared by the faculty in harmony with the legal requirements of the state and goals, objectives and academic standards approved by the Board of Education.

Curriculum guides shall be developed. These guides should provide a consistent approach to course content and information relating to supplementary materials and related activities.

The superintendent shall have general coordinating authority and supervision over the formation of all course outlines and instructional objectives.
