READING INSTRUCTION

The Board of Education supports the following reading goals for the School district of Cambridge:

- 1. A coordinated developmental reading program shall be made available for students at all grade levels and shall be under the direction of a certified reading specialist.
- 2. Instruction in reading is one of the basic skills areas.
- 3. A variety of learning materials and teaching techniques shall be used to accommodate individual student ability and achievement.
- 4. Parent/guardian involvement in home-school cooperative efforts to help each student reach his/her reading potential is encouraged.
- 5. Remedial reading services will be provided for students in grades kindergarten through four who meet the criteria outlined in the state law and to other students who may be in need of such services.
- 6. The reading program and student achievement shall be evaluated annually.
