SCHOOL DISTRICT OF CAMBRIDGE

EDUCATION FOR EMPLOYMENT

POLICY #341.2

The School District of Cambridge Board of Education shall provide an education for employment program for elementary and secondary students which has been developed in accordance with state guidelines and has been approved by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction. The program shall provide information on career awareness at the elementary grade levels, career exploration at the middle grade levels and career planning and preparation at the high school levels.

The Superintendent, or designee, shall coordinate the education for employment program in accordance with state laws and regulations. Education for employment program records shall be maintained and reports shall be made as required by the Department of Public Instruction.

The District may participate in an Education for Employment Consortium.
