

The School District of Cambridge shall provide instructional opportunities for its students in human growth and development as part of the District's health education program in grades kindergarten through 12.

Annually, the Board of Education shall provide the parent(s)/guardian of each student enrolled in the District with an outline of the human growth and development curriculum used in the health education program and information on how the parent or guardian may inspect the complete curriculum and instructional materials. The human growth and development curriculum and instructional materials shall be available upon request for inspection at any time.

No student shall be required to take courses or participate in units of the human growth and development curriculum if his/her parent(s) or guardian files a written objection to such offerings with the principal. An alternate unit option shall be provided for students who are exempted from a unit, with an outline of the alternate option being sent home to parents/guardians.
