GIFTED AND TALENTED PROGRAM

Gifted and talented services shall be maintained to provide the potentially high achieving student with an opportunity to develop skills in inquiry and creative expression at a rate and to an extent appropriate to his/her ability. "Gifted and talented students" may include those students who give evidence of high performance capability in intellectual, creative, artistic, leadership or specific academic areas and who need educational services or activities not ordinarily provided in a regular school program.

Students are identified as gifted and talented in accordance with state guidelines.
