

The Board of Education shall establish programs to serve children in the School District of Cambridge who are identified as being at risk of not graduating from high school, in accordance with state law. All programs developed for children at risk should be designed to:

- a. Improve and expand educational opportunities for these children on an individualized basis, through a variety of means (e.g. remedial instruction, Project Succeed);
- b. Provide alternative courses or program modifications which satisfactorily meet the District graduation requirements;
- c. Encourage parental involvement; and
- d. Encourage cooperation with community support service agencies.

Students shall be identified and referred to these programs in accordance with state regulations and guidelines established by the administration.
