This exemption shall extend to any application for assistance or tax abatement or waiver ofee, fine, or other levy, if based on inability to pay or poverty of the applicant.
- O **RSA 91-A:3 II(d)** Consideration of the acquisition, sale or lease of real or personal property which, if discussed in public, would likely benefit a party or parties whose interests are adverse to those of the general community.
- O **RSA 91-A:3 II(e)** Consideration or negotiation of pending claims or litigation which has been threatened in writing or filed against the body or agency or any subdivision thereof, or against any member thereof because of his or her membership in such body or agency, until the claim or litigation has been fully adjudicated or otherwise settled. Any application filed for tax abatement, pursuant to law, with any body or board shall not constitute a threatened or filed litigation against any body, board, or agency for the purposes of this subparagraph.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE SUBJECT MATTER DISCUSSED AND FINAL DECISIONS:

*The Board continued discussion regarding S. Cooper's position.

After much discussion, R. Horton offered \$70,000 for the Special Ed Director position.

- S. Cooper advised if it is an Administrative Contract, the salary must be \$72,000.
- T. Croteau advised L. Schmidt to put \$72,000 in for this line item (\$70,000 and \$2,000 for buy-out); will put in two separate categories.
- *The Board agreed to cut the Chinese teacher position.
- *T. Croteau advised the Board needs to let the Budget Committee know that teacher retirement/contracts, Keene tuition, etc. are items they have no control over.
