

Alaska Gateway School District Instrument Use Agreement

Dear Guitar/Fiddle Family,

The Alaska Gateway School District is providing an instrument, without rental charge, for this student to use for the 2016-2017 School Year. The following are some guidelines and expectations you should be aware of for the care of the instrument, case, and accessories while it is in your possession. Most of these guidelines are common sense, but we would like to draw your attention to a few key points. Please remember that we expect this instrument to be in good working order for future students. Instruments are an expensive investment that the school district has made with the expectation that they will be treated carefully.

The student is responsible for the taking good care of this instrument while it is in their possession. **The student will also be help responsible for repair or replacement costs of the instrument, case, or accessories if they are damaged, lost, stolen or destroyed while checked out to the student.** The student will pay those repair or replacement costs to Alaska Gateway School District within thirty (30) days of notification of the costs incurred.

At the end of the school year, the instrument should be returned in proper working order with all of its accessories. If the student decides to no longer participate in band or moves out of the district, the instrument needs to be returned immediately to the school.

Before the student can check out an instrument to take home, this form needs to be completed and signed by both the student and their parent.

By signing this form, the parents and student assume liability for the instrument during the school year. If the student is no longer a member of the music class or moves out of the district, the instrument needs to be returned at that time.
