

BOARD ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

The annual organizational meeting of the Board will be held at the regular meeting in July, unless otherwise designated by the Board at the previous regular meeting.

The Board from the previous year will begin the meeting by finishing up any business needed to close out the previous school year. That meeting will then be adjourned. After that portion of the meeting is done, any Board members not returning will be dismissed from the table and new members will be invited up.

The meeting will be called to order and the oath of office given to all new Board members. The Board will elect a chairman and vice-chairman from its membership, to serve until the next annual meeting. The superintendent or the business manager will preside over the election of the president.

Other items will include, but not be limited to, the following: Designation of official depository; designation of the custodians of all accounts; designation of official legal newspaper; authorization of continuation of existing funds or accounts and the establishment of any new accounts, if necessary; setting of date, time, and place for regular meetings; reviewing and adopting of board policies; establishment of advisory committees where applicable; reviewing of bonds for business manager and other bonded personnel; appointment of administrator of trust and agency accounts; appointment of individual authorized to direct federal programs; authorization of administrator to institute school lunch agreement; authorization of advertising of bids for materials not already purchased; authorization of business manager to invest and reinvest funds in institution, which serves greatest advantage to school district; setting admission charges for year; setting lunch prices for the year; authorization of superintendent to close school in an emergency situation and to change calendar to make up days lost to emergency closings.
