

Athletic Hall of Fame

Guidelines and Criteria

Hall of Fame nominees shall include individuals who have raised the level of awareness in Alliance City School's athletics through their distinguished athletic achievement or through their contributions to Alliance City School's athletics in other fields of work. These individuals may include student-athletes, coaches, or contributors. Nominees may be retired from their field, or still active. Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and moral character.

- 1. The categories of student-athlete, coach, and contributor are included on the nomination form for expediency in understanding the primary area in which an individual is to be considered. These groupings are for screening purposes only and to assist those making the nomination in understanding the type of information required. Once a nominee is inducted, he or she will not be categorized; all are recognized as members of the Alliance High School Athletic Hall of Fame. To further explain:
 - A **student-athlete** is a former student participant who is being nominated for his or her achievements in high school athletics. To be eligible for nomination, a student-athlete must have graduated from Alliance High School at least 5 years ago. Student-athletes will be considered primarily on their achievements as a high school student-athlete. Such achievements being considered include All-League, All-County, or All-State recognition. Character during and after their high school years will be a major consideration.
 - A **coach** will be considered primarily for his or her achievements while coaching in Alliance City Schools. Secondary consideration will be given to the nominee's achievements as a collegiate or professional coach. The nominee's character at both Alliance City Schools and other levels will receive major consideration.
 - A **contributor** is an individual who has made *outstanding* contributions to interscholastic athletic programs at Alliance City Schools. A nominee will be considered primarily on the merits of his or her contributions to Alliance City School's athletics. The nominee's character will also receive consideration.

- 2. All nominees will be judged on their significant and/or long-term contributions to Alliance City School's athletics. Longevity, without meaningful impact, does not constitute appropriate credentials for Hall of Fame consideration. The Hall of Fame Screening Committee may consider a nominee's total record of contribution to Alliance City School's athletics in determining eligibility for candidacy and not just his or her record of service in the category in which the nomination is made.
 - The Screening Committee also may waive the minimum years of service requirement when exceptional circumstances such as injury, illness, or death have prevented an otherwise worthy candidate from meeting the requirement.
 - Inductees of the Hall of Fame are considered role models for the student athletes in Alliance City Schools. As such, the Alliance Hall of Fame Committee reserves the right to remove from the Hall of Fame those inductees who have not maintained the same standards required for induction.
- **3**. The induction process will take place biannually. To be considered within an induction year, nominations must be received by August 31st.
- **4.** During an induction year, 3-5 nominees will be inducted into the Hall of Fame, based upon the numbers of nominations received. All nominations remain on file for consideration again during subsequent induction years.
- **5**. The Selection Committee will choose the date and setting for the induction ceremony.
- **6**. The inductee's picture will be displayed in the Alliance High School Hall of Fame located in the lobby of Alliance High School.
- 7. A nominee will be inducted by majority vote of the Selection Committee. The Selection Committee will be comprised of the following:
 - 1- Alliance High School Athletic Director or designee (Chairperson)
 - 1- Alliance High School Principal or designee
 - 1- Former teacher or former coach at Alliance City Schools
 - 1- Alliance Review Sports Editor or designee
 - 3- Active members of the Aviator Sports Boosters, appointed by vote of ASB membership
- **8.** Each inductee will have the opportunity to choose the person they wish to be their presenter for the ceremony.
