Enrichment Descriptions:

Stem: Offered Tuesday/Thursday

STEM is based on the idea of educating students in four specific disciplines – science, technology, engineering and mathematics. Rather than teach the four disciplines as separate and discrete subjects, STEM integrates these subjects into a cohesive learning experience based on real world applications.

Craft: Offered Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

This class is great for students to develop fine motor skills! Students learn how to work with different materials including, but not limited to paper, scissors, crayons, markers, tissue paper, glue, paper plates, and more! Students can create beautiful artwork they can be proud of.

Board Games: Offered Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

Students engage in fun games that help develop a variety of skills such as math, reading, teamwork, problem solving, and communication skills. All games are age appropriate, and students are grouped according to grade level.

Reader's Theater: Offered Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

Combine the joys of reading and acting all in one class! Students can improve reading comprehension and fluency without having to memorize lines, and adding their own creative flair. This class is a theater class without the need for props- the emphasis is on the student.

Brilliant Builders: offered Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

This class is a great choice for those who love to build and create using traditional items like blocks and legos, as well as nontraditional items like recyclables, cups, toothpicks, and marshmallows. Students can let their creativity show through hands on fun.

Sports: offered Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

Students who are full of energy will love this club! Children will learn how to follow directions, rules, and teamwork while learning a variety of indoor and outdoor games that help develop large muscle skills and flexibility.

Computers: offered Monday/Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday

In this age of technology students can take advantage of learning how to manipulate a keyboard and mouse, the proper ways to access kid appropriate programs and games, and how to create special projects using technology.

Garden: offered Monday/Wednesday

This club promotes the love and knowledge of gardening through our desire to educate our youth about gardening and the natural world. Students will learn how gardens make our community, home, and school beautiful. Students will learn how to plant a variety of flowers, vegetables, and plants.
