

The Challenges

Pre K - 5

- Small Classroom space creates overcrowding and limits student engagement opportunities
- No breakout spaces for small group instruction
- Narrow Hallway leads to congestion and safety issues
- Restrooms do not meet ADA standards and are deteriorating from age
- Electrical and technology infrastructure do not meet 21st Century Educational needs
- Kindergarten and pre-k classroom are in annex buildings

Security

- Unsecure entrance into the School
- No sightlines from front door to main office
- Community fitness room accessibility does not comply with best practice for security
- Kindergarten and pre-k classrooms are outside the main building increasing vulnerability

Community and School

- Insufficient locker room space; classrooms are being used for locker rooms
- Weight and fitness room updates are limited by size of room and ceiling height
- Inadequate space for community and school activities during school and after school
- Physical education classes are displaced to accommodate program and event scheduling
- No dedicated space to set up multi day events or displays for student activities such as science fair and drama events
- Practice schedules begin at 5 AM and run until 9 PM to accommodate all age groups resulting in increased dangerous winter driving for students and 10 to 12 hour days for students

The Solution

Pre K-5

- Enlarge elementary classrooms by converting 6 existing classrooms to 4 classrooms and one breakout room; add 4 new classrooms
- Move student cubbies from hallway to classroom widening hallway by 2 feet
- Remodel restrooms in elementary and high school to update plumbing and improve ADA accessibility
- Upgrade electrical and computer connections to meet current 21st Century instructional needs and increase computer accessibility
- Move kindergarten and pre-k into the main building for added security

Security

- Expand the vestibule and add security camera and buzzer system to front entrance
- Move fitness room and weight room to multipurpose area and create an exterior entrance for community with limited access to instructional areas for increased security and accessibility to the entire community
- Move Kindergarten and pre-k into main building

Community and School

- Add two locker rooms
- Design weight and fitness room to accommodate fitness equipment
- Add a multipurpose area to accommodate school and community activities
- Schedule multipurpose area for extracurricular programs and events, instructional displays, and community use
- Schedule elementary and MS practices in multi-purpose area decreasing the need to schedule early and late practices
