Public invited to participate in discussion on school facilities

KILMARNOCK—A series of public meetings will be held to gather information from parents and the community on the future needs of school facilities. The meetings will be held at 6:30 p.m. December 1 and 8, and January 5, at the LCPS Annex (The old community library), 235 School Street.

“This is a process that requires input from the community,” said superintendent Steve Parker. “Because the resulting plan will chart the course for our schools and the future economic development of our community, it’s important for citizens to be involved.”

The facilities committee of the Lancaster County Public School Board has invited the Charlottesville based architectural firm VMDO to lead a series of discussions with the community that will be the basis of planning for new or renovated facilities that will serve county children for the next 75 years.

“We understand this is a busy time of year for everyone. But it is also critical to get a jump start before the budget planning process begins in January,” said Parker.
