PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS AND ADVERTISING IN THE SCHOOLS

SOLICITING: No person will sell or offer for sale within school buildings or on school property any articles or services, or solicit contributions, except those approved by the Superintendent or the Board. This policy does not prohibit any school or school sponsored activity fund-raising authorized by the Board and the school administration.

Salespeople are prohibited from talking to teachers at any time during the school day. Salespeople representing educational companies may be granted this opportunity by making arrangements through the principal's office, at a time that will not interfere with the classroom work of the teacher.

ADVERTISING: No notices or advertisements by or in behalf of persons not officially connected with the schools will be distributed in any school building except by permission of the Superintendent or Board. All notices, even by school personnel, will be cleared by the Superintendent.

CHARITY FUND-RAISING: The administration may select a special fund or charity project which is considered important. Approval for such a project must be secured from the Superintendent.

NON-CURRICULAR ANNOUNCEMENTS: The Board recognizes that students, employees, parents, or citizens may want to distribute materials within the school district that are non-curricular. Non-curricular materials to be distributed must be approved by the building principal and meet certain standards prior to their distribution.
