

STUDENT PROGRESS REPORTS AND CONFERENCES

The Board feels that it is essential for parents to be kept fully informed of their children's progress in school.

PROGRESS REPORTS: The type of progress reports sent to parents will be devised by the professional staff in cooperation with parents. Report cards will be uniform throughout the District at comparable grade levels except as special forms may be developed for special programs or new forms tried out on a temporary basis.

Report cards will be distributed on a quarterly basis. Each quarter grade will be based on many factors, such as: basal text assignment, both oral and written; class participation; special assignments; research; activities of various types and kinds; special contributions.

Supplementary reports will be given during each quarter.

PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES: Conferences with parents will be held twice a year. The Board encourages all parents, students, and staff to keep open lines of communication. If an issue arises in between conference time, it is the best interest of all parties to get it resolved in a timely manner.

Parents are encouraged to call or email teachers as issues arise. Teachers are encouraged to work with the parents to come up with a reasonable solution to those issues.
