MINUTES

March 10, 2014

The North Little Rock School District Board met in special session on Monday March 10, 2014, in the Board Room of the Administration Building of the North Little Rock School District, 2700 Poplar Street, North Little Rock, Arkansas. President J.T. Zakrzewski called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

Former Belwood Elementary Property Contract

Adam Jenkins with Newmark Grubb of Arkansas, real estate agent, explained that the proposed General Addendum of the former Belwood Elementary property with the added language to restrict the "usage, leasing or development of an educational facility" to compete with the North Little Rock School District is not acceptable to the proposed buyers of this property. Mr. Jenkins stated that if this addendum is approved, the buyer will decline buying the property. The buyer does not want any restricted language on the contract.

Scott Miller moved to reject the proposed restricted language General Addendum and retain the acceptance of the offer of the \$495,000 with Ghan Properties. Scott Teague seconded the motion.

Former Baring Cross Elementary Property

Mr. Rodgers along with Mr. Jenkins presented the proposed contract to sell the former Baring Cross Elementary property for \$85,000 to North Little Rock Housing Authority. Mr. Rodgers said he thought the offer was too low for this property.

Webhosting Contract to include E-Rate

Mr. Brown explained the RFP process was completed and Intrafinity/SharpSchool had the best bid to include E-rate. He explained there would immediate savings with this company.

T.I.F. Final Disbursement

Mr. Rodgers explained he wanted to move monies from another fund so the District would not have to withhold their 25% for FICA and Teacher Retirement of the \$123,000 TIF final settlement payment. The only reductions would be the employee's share for Teacher Retirement and FICA. The disbursement of these funds will be to full-time employees and Mrs. Drennan stated would be sent out to employees prior to Spring Break.

Ron Treat moved to accept Administration's recommendation to transfer the 25% for the District's portion for the FICA and Teacher Retirement from another fund. Scott Teague seconded the motion.
