SUBJECT: FINGERPRINTING OF SPORTS OFFICIALS

New York State law and regulations require that all prospective District employees be fingerprinted and receive clearance from the State Education Department in order to work in the District. With respect to officials at sporting events, the District will require that all sports officials be fingerprinted and receive clearance through the State Education Department prior to their hiring and/or retention by the District. No sports official who refuses to comply with this policy with respect to fingerprinting and clearance shall be permitted to officiate any game and/or contest involving District students.

The Athletic Department, in conjunction with the Superintendent's Office, shall formulate appropriate regulations to ensure the orderly processing of all fingerprints for sports officials as well as the monitoring of same.
