ARKADELPHIA BOARD OF EDUCATION OFFICIAL MINUTES: APRIL 19, 2016

The Arkadelphia Board of Education met in regular session Tuesday, April 19, 2016, at 6:00 p.m.in the Boardroom of the Administration Building, located at 235 North Eleventh Street.

Members Present: Dr. Jeff Root, President; Dr. Kenneth G. Harris, Jr., Vice President; Ms. Karrie Goodman, Secretary; Mr. Billy Groom, Dr. Casey Motl, and Mr. Randy Turner. Member absent: Ms. Gina White. The President called the meeting to order and established a quorum with six (6) members present.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the regular meeting of March 17; and special meeting of April 5, 2016 were approved with correction to the April 5 minutes regarding board members in attendance.

INSTRUCTIONAL REPORT

Dr. Jeanette Turner, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, provided an update on the ACT Aspire test.

REPORT OF EXCELLENCE

Dr. Jeanette Turner, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, introduced AHS students who were recognized for honors in extracurricular activities.

FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The Board and Superintendent reviewed the District's financial statements for March, 2016.

CONSIDERATION OF CLASSIFIED SALARY SCHEDULE PROPOSAL

Upon the recommendation of the Classified PPC and the Administration, a motion was made by Dr. Harris, seconded by Ms. Goodman, and carried 6-0 to approve the proposed Classified staff salary increase of approximately 9.6 percent.

CONSIDERATION OF SPECIAL EDUCATION

Upon the recommendation of the Supt; a motion was made by Dr. Harris, seconded by Ms. Goodman, and carried 6-0 to approve the Special Education 2016-17 budget as presented.

FACILITIES UPDATE

Dr. Whitten reported that the construction bidding process would begin in late fall, with construction beginning in February, 2017. Items being considered include finalizing square footage prior to budgetary planning.

CONSIDERATION OF BID APPROVAL FOR IPADS AND CART (PERRITT)

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, a motion was made by Mr. Turner, seconded by Dr. Motl, and carried 6-0 to accept the bid of Apple (Single source provider)@ \$16,445.47 through the TIPPS/TAPPS program, state vendor @ \$16,445.47 for purchase of iPads and iPad cart for Perritt Primary School.

Policy Review: 8.32a – Insurance – Bus Drivers (Deletion)

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, a motion was made by Dr. Motl, seconded by Dr. Harris, and carried 6-0 to approve deletion of Board **Policy 8.32a-Insurance – Bus Drivers**.

CONSIDERATION OF SOCIAL STUDIES TEXTBOOK ADOPTION

The Superintendent reported on the Social Studies textbook adoption process conducted by Dr. Jeanette Turner, and assisted by a committee member composed of teachers, parents, principals, and administrative staff members. Upon the recommendation of the Administration, a motion was made by Dr. Harris, seconded by Mr. Turner, and carried 6-0 to approve the adoption of the following Social Studies textbooks for K-12:

Perritt Primary School, Central Primary School, and Peake Elementary School: Social Studies Networks Program by McGraw-Hill.

Goza Middle School: Programs by McGraw-Hill and Gibbs Smith Education **Arkadelphia High School:** Programs by Wadsworth Cengage Learning, Pearson, Holt McDougal, McGraw-Hill and McGraw-Hill Glencoe.

MISCELLANEOUS

The Board received a report on the NSBA annual conference that was held in Boston, April 11-14 and was attended by Dr. Whitten, Dr. Harris and Dr. Root.

PERSONNEL

Upon the recommendation of the Administration, a motion was made by Dr. Harris, seconded by Dr. Motl, and carried 6-0 to approve re-employment of the classified staff members recommended on the attached list.
