

## ACCIDENT PREVENTION AND SAFETY PROCEDURES

Student safety will be considered a part of the general education program. All staff will take their responsibility to supervise students seriously and will re-direct any student or staff member that is acting in an unsafe manner.

To the extent possible, classroom teachers will also find ways to work in safety instruction into the educational program, taking time out of class to re-direct and correct any unsafe behaviors that are occurring under their supervision.

Students in science, art, agriculture, or other classes where safety rules are necessary, will be given an orientation each semester to familiarize them with the equipment and materials they will be using and the dangers involved if safety precautions are not taken. Signs will be posted in rooms as a constant reminder of these safety precautions. Any student acting in an unsafe manner during these classes that puts other students, staff members, or community members in danger will be removed from those activities for the remainder of the semester.

Coaches and advisors will also do all within their power to help prevent accidents or further injuries to the students. This may include prevention methods like stretching and icing after practices, to consultation with an athletic trainer, to preventing the student from participating until medically cleared.
