## Types of Diplomas

Diplomas	Descriptions
<b>Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation with Honors</b>	Same requirements as Regents with Advanced Designation plus an <b>average</b> of 90.0 overall on all 9 Regents Exams. No rounding up permitted.
<b>Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation</b>	Students must score 65% on all 8 Regents Exams required and earn 22 units of credit. (English, Global History, US History, Integrated Algebra, Geometry and Trigonometry, Living Environment or Earth Science, & Spanish (excluded if student replaced Foreign Language with vocational or art concentration.)
<b>Regents Diploma with Honors</b>	Same requirements as Regents Diploma plus an <b>average</b> of 90.0 or above on all 5 Regents exams. No rounding up permitted.
<b>Regents Diploma</b>	Students must score 65% on all five Regents Exams (English, Global History, US History, Integrated Algebra, and Living Environment) and earn 22 units of credit.
<b>Local Diploma</b>	Students with disabilities may score 55% or higher on 3 Regents exams; 65% or higher on ELA and Math Regents.
<b>Technical Endorsement</b>	Available to students who satisfy local or Regents diploma requirements and successfully complete a State Education Department approved Career/Technical Education Program.
<b>Career Development and Occupational Studies (CDOS) Commencement Credential</b>	Available only to students with disabilities in order to 1) supplement a diploma, or 2) act as exiting credential for students unable to earn a High School Diploma.
<b>Test Assessing Secondary Completion (formerly GED)</b>	Issued from NYS Education Department (not CCS) for students who are enrolled in approved TASC (alternative) program who successfully/pass the TASC examination. CCS does not offer a TASC program.
