

## Students on Governing Boards

### A. Term of Office

One student representative will be selected by the Prescott School District Board of Directors in the spring of the year to serve on the board for the following year. Two student representatives will serve on the Prescott School Board each year...one student a Junior and one student a Senior. Each student representative will serve a two-year term beginning in July and concluding in June. After the student representatives are selected they will receive an orientation session provided by the superintendent (or designee) and a member of the board of directors.

### B. Qualifications

The student must be entering his/her junior or senior year at the time of selection. The student is in good academic standing, and is required to maintain good academic standing throughout his or her term. Selected students should also have a history of leadership and involvement in extra-curricular and civic activities.

### C. Responsibilities

Student representatives will obey all the rules and regulations pertaining to board members. Student representatives will receive copies of all regular meeting agendas, minutes and other relevant information, excluding executive session materials.

The board may remove a student representative during the term if he/she becomes ineligible or fails to fulfill his/her responsibilities. In the event a vacancy arises prior to the expiration of the term, an alternate will be appointed by the Board to fill the vacancy.
