# **ADDITION OF AGENDA ITEM**

The Board appointed Dr. Kenneth G. Harris, Jr. as the delegate to the 2014 assembly of the Arkansas School Board Association to be held in Little Rock on December 10-12.

## CONSIDERATION OF BOARD STUDY CIRCLE PLAN

The Board discussed Arkansas Study Circles Project (ASCP), a training model provided by the Arkansas School Board Association. The study circles incorporate groups of 8-12 people – parents, students, community residents, business leaders, and teachers who meet multiple times to discuss issues facing their community, school district or school. Leaders for the groups include a neutral facilitator, recorder, and discussion guide.

A motion was made by Dr. Motl, seconded by Dr. Harris, and carried 6-0 to approve the Study Circle Plan and move forward in a timely manner for the Board to provide implementation.

# SALARY REPORT APPROVAL

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, a motion was made by Dr. Motl, seconded by Ms. King, and carried 6-0 to approve the Salary Report of Act 1120 Salary Increases.

# **CONSIDERATION OF A BID FOR TRACTOR PURCHASE**

A motion was made by Dr. Harris, seconded by Dr. Motl, and carried 6-0 to authorize selling a portion of land on the Perritt property that was purchased in 2007, with Board member Randy Turner representing the Board in the process.
